

About the situation on earth



Students in 1st and 7th grades at our school, Hraunvallaskóli, did a project together about our planet.

They focused on three things:

- 1) How is the situation on our planet today in the year 2018?
- 2) How will the situation on earth be in the year 2030, if we continue treating it in the same manner?
- 3) What can we do to make it better?

They made tapestries where each of them focused on a different theme according to their project. The youngest students did some brainstorming and then they made some questions and sentences that they then clued on a fabric. In all they produced three tapestries.

The students along with their teachers decided to invite the major at Hafnarfjörður to our school and present their project to him.

When the major came the student's in 7th grade welcomed him and told him about the Green Clean Future project. They told him about our mascot and things that we are focusing on in the project, like food waste, climate change, recycle and reduce, sustainable travel, plastic and so on. Then they walked around the school with the major to show him our recycle bins before they went into the classroom where the 1st grade students waited. The student's in 7th grade introduced each of the three tapestry for the major.



The major was impressed with their project and he asked the students many questions, he also told them a little story from his childhood how things were back in those days. People really didn't think about their environment so much and they did all kinds of silly things that people nowadays would never do, like throwing trash on the street and more.



Before the major left, the students sang for him and gave him presents. One of them was a book about how he can read the clouds to predict the weather and the other was a smaller version of a tapestry that he took with him and placed up on a wall in front of his office.
